Freedom First members and dependents of members are eligible to apply.

Charles Perkins Scholarships

These scholarships are named in honor of Charles Perkins, who served as general manager and president of Freedom First Credit Union. Three \$1,500 scholarships are awarded each year in his name.

Fritz Kehn Scholarship

The \$1,500 Fritz Kehn scholarship is dedicated to the memory of Fred D. "Fritz" Kehn, one of the original members of the Credit Union. A former General Electric sheet metal foreman in Salem, Fritz served as the first Credit Union president in 1956. His dedication continued as a member of the Board of Directors.

City of Salem/Frank Turk Scholarship

A \$1,500 scholarship is awarded each year in recognition of the City of Salem Employees Credit Union. Frank Turk served as its president from 1978 to 2004 and was elected to the Freedom First Board of Directors in 2004.

Tim Sutphin Scholarship

A \$1,500 scholarship is dedicated to the memory of Tim Sutphin, who served on the Freedom First Board of Directors for over 20 years. Tim's compassion and uncompromising belief in the Credit Union principle of "People Helping People" gives solid foundation to the honor and high praise he has earned from Credit Union volunteers and members he has served over the years.

Qualifications

- High School senior or college student with a minimum of one semester remaining until degree. Adult learners and/or individuals taking workforce or career certification courses may also apply.
- Must be a member of Freedom First Credit Union.
- City of Salem/Frank Turk Scholarship applicants must have an employment relationship with the City of Salem, City of Salem School Division, or Blue Ridge Behavioral Healthcare.

Required Information

- A completed application form with attachments must be received by **3:00 p.m. on May 3, 2024.**
- An official high school (if you are a high school senior) or college (if you are a college student) transcript.
- One letter of recommendation. Can be from a friend, family member, employer, teacher, school counselor, or school administrator.

Judging

Applicants will be judged on academic achievement, work ethic, civic involvement, financial need, and an essay. Greater consideration will be given to applications that have demonstrated a financial need. An independent committee will review the applications. Winners will be notified by phone or letter.
